Amalgamated Holdings Ltd. (AHL) is Australia's premier entertainment, hospitality and tourism and leisure company. Its three main operating divisions are Entertainment, Entertainment Technology and Hospitality and Leisure.

David joined Amalgamated Holdings Limited in February 1988 as Chief Executive of the Hotel Division. He has been recognised as the founder of Rydges Hotels & Resorts, which is currently one of the largest Australian-owned hotel operators with nearly 7000 rooms at locations across Australia, New Zealand, and United Kingdom.

The Company recently launched the QT Hotels & Resorts brand with individual design driven properties in Sydney, Gold Coast, Port Douglas, Falls Creek and Canberra and plans for development of properties in Perth and Melbourne. The company also operates the value positioned Atura brand.

In 2000 David took on the additional role of Executive Director of the Greater Union Cinema Organisation taking responsibility for the Company's cinema and film related interests, Globally AHL is the 10th largest cinema exhibitor with operations in Australia, New Zealand, Fiji and Germany.

David was appointed Group Managing Director of Amalgamated Holdings Limited in late 2001. Amalgamated is an Australian listed company with market capitalization in excess of \$1.9 Billion. In addition to owning the Hotel and Cinema brands, and an extensive property portfolio, Amalgamated also owns some of Australia's most iconic and recognisable assets including the Thredbo Alpine Ski Resort and Sydney's State Theatre.
